Read *John 21:15-23*.

2. Comparison is holding one thing up against another and making a judgment, and in and of itself, comparison is neither good nor bad.
 - a. In what ways are you prone to comparison?
 - b. When your comparison turns bad (you are comparing yourself to someone else and sinning as a result), what lies and deceptions from the world, the flesh or the devil are you believing which are causing your comparison to be such?
 - c. What are some of the good and positive sides to comparison? What are Scriptural truths you must believe in order to "do comparison" right?
 - d. How does the idea of calling come in and interact with and overwhelm the propensity to practice bad comparing? How has it worked in your life? What are some things we must believe (from the Scriptures) in order for calling to conquer comparison?
3. Ryan mentioned three areas of comparison in the message. What are they, and which ones can you relate to the most these days? Why? Also, how did the "calling" (which served as the anti-dote to the comparison) help you? Why?
