Engaging With Each Other

1. What's the best job you've ever had? Why? What's the worst? Why?

Engaging With the Scripture

Read Ephesians 6:5-9; Ephesians 1:9-10; Ephesians 2:13-17; Ephesians 4:1-3

The big idea from this week's message is two-fold: First, God wants us to understand that our work is a tool in His hands that He uses as He works to reconcile unreconciled people to Himself and that He uses to help already reconciled people live in peace with each other. (Obviously this isn't all the Bible has to say about work, but it is what Paul has to say about it here.) Second, He wants us to live out our understanding in our work-a-day lives. To do that, He gives us very practical steps to take.

2. What are your thoughts as you consider, or re-consider, what Paul wants you to learn about the purpose of your work and how it fits into God's plans for reconciliation and unity (and let's define work as anything you do to either earn a living or to help make living possible)?
3. Assuming you want to continue to work with this perspective, or begin to work with this perspective, what are some important practices that you bring into your work day, or what would be some important practices that you can bring into your work day, which will help you do this? (It might be helpful to think in terms of "perspective practices" and "production practices" as you craft a response.)

4. There were, no doubt, lots of perspective and production practices that you discussed in question three. What are one or two that you can apply to your life as you seek to live as Jesus would if he were you?
